100% Organic production.  
Incredibly low dosages, most in the range of 4-5 grams per liter.  
No machinery in the vineyards. (See *Venus on the cover sheet*)  
Has only one vineyard outside of the Grand Cru villages, the rest of his fruit is 100% Grand Cru.  
Very lean and tightly-wound style, this is easily the “geekiest” of our producers, for those who want “chalk in a glass”! Among the best expressions of the soils of Champagne you will ever have in a glass.

## Gatinois

The Gatinois family can trace their winemaking heritage in the Grand Cru village of Ay back 12 generations. They own 17 acres of vineyards, divided up into 29 different parcels.

Production is roughly 50,000 bottles per year.

The Cuvée Tradition is 90% Pinot noir & 10% Chardonnay. The rosé is mostly Pinot noir with a little Chardonnay blended in. There is no inoculation - only naturally occurring yeast start the fermentations. There is no oak used. As Pierre always said, “Oak is an artifice that everyone uses today to make something different, yet they all end up making something very similar!”

Whatever fruit Gatinois does not use is sold exclusively to their next-door neighbor, Bollinger (*and they only use it for their Tete de Cuvée, Grand Anne*). You can be sure that Gatinois is not selling better fruit to Bollinger than what they are keeping for their own wines.

## Larmandier-Bernier

Certified Biodynamic.

A simple but demanding recipe for great Champagne: old vines, working the soil, moderate yields, no fertilizer and mature grapes picked by hand. In the winery: natural and spontaneous primary and malolactic fermentations. Aged on the lees for a full year before racking and transferring to bottle for the secondary fermentation, then another 2 years in bottle before hand-disgorgement. Never more than 5 GPL sugar in the final dosage. This labor-intensive process yields spectacular Champagnes with a remarkable level of power, depth and finesse all at once.

## Laurent Lequart

Practicing organic; HVE-certified Sustainable.

Laurent Lequart is a 4<sup>th</sup> generation grower in Passy-Grigny in the Marne, producing fewer than 6000 cases annually, and almost entirely focused on Pinot Meunier (roughly 80% of their production). Hand-harvested, full malolactic fermentations and long aging on lees (30-72 months). The wines are uniquely stunning, from profile to price.

## R.H. Coutier

Certified Sustainable.

Founded in 1882 by Rene's Grandfather, the Coutier family can trace their winemaking heritage back to 1619! Coutier was the first to plant Chardonnay in the Grand Cru village of Ambonnay. The Cuvée is 60% Pinot Noir and 40% Chardonnay. No oak is ever used; Cuvée is dosed at 5 GPL; only half of the still wines see malolactic fermentation. In *Four Thousand Champagnes*, Richard Juhlin gives R. H. Coutier a well-deserved 4-star rating, and calls Rene "The Uncrowned King of Ambonnay".

## Selosse

When Anselme Selosse started making wine in the 1980s, he developed the then-radical philosophy that any great Champagne must first be a great wine. The brilliance of his mind, and the deftness of his touch, is mirrored in every bottle he's ever made. About 5 years ago, Anselme passed the baton to a young winemaker widely regarded as a genius: his son, Guillaume. With roughly 50k bottles produced annually, these wines are truly as rare as they are exceptional, earning their status as one of the great cult Champagne producers.

### Voirin-Jumel

Fourth-generation winegrowers and 3rd generation winemakers with 27 acres centered around the Grand Cru village of Cramant in the northern Côte Blancs. Most of the portfolio are 100% Chardonnay, (with the exception of one small vineyard outside of Cramant that is 100% Pinot Noir that they use to make their small-production Blanc de noir). The wines are a softer, creamier style than our other Côte blancs producers. Our most all-encompassing Champagne in terms of style. Classic toast on the nose, lemon chess pie flavors in the mid-palate and a lovely, long dry finish showing more fresh lemons.

### Bott-Geyl

Christian Bott makes this wine from purchased fruit (which he only buys from growers that farm organically and pick by hand). It is a blend of Pinot Blanc, Chardonnay & Pinot noir (vinified as a white wine). The wine spends 24 months on the lees after the secondary fermentation (before disgorgement), and is bottled with less than 5 grams per liter of sugar. It is bone dry, and while it shows the depth of great Alsatian wine, is still very light on its feet.

## Domaine Huet

The Petillant Brut from this legendary is made by the Methode Ancestrale, from younger vines in all three of their most famous vineyards: Le Haut-Lieu, Le Mont & Clos du Bourg, considered by many to be among the greatest vineyards in all of Vouvray. Bottled while there's still some sugar to finish fermentation in the bottle, resulting in a gently bubbly wine. After 3+ years in the bottle, the wines are disgorged and given a balancing dosage (~10g/l) from a great Huet Moelleux or 1er Trie.

## Mas de Daumas Gassac

From one of the most esteemed estates in the Languedoc. The sparkling rose is a blend of Cabernet sauvignon and Mourvèdre, free-run juice fermented in steel tanks for a lively, fruit-forward bubbly. The Folie (actually, "Foliiiie") is a blanc de blanc from 100% Chardonnay, aged on lees and showing minerality on the palate with a note of grapefruit zest.

## Perrachon

Laurent has selected a portion of his Chardonnay vineyard for this wine. He makes the first "cuvée" himself in the cellars of the Domaine de la Bottière. He uses all his expertise to build the wine structure: its body, its acidity, its refined palate. He then trusts this wine to an elaborator, who oversees the secondary bottle fermentation, which takes around 9 months. You will find all the subtlety of the Chardonnay in this Crémant Blanc de Blanc. Bold, fresh nose, subtle palate with flowery notes, slightly lemony and vibrant acidity.

## Rathfinny

Founded in 2010 by husband and wife Mark and Sarah Driver, Rathfinny is situated on the chalky soils of East Sussex where they produce some of the world's finest sparkling wine. Once a working, arable farm, the first vines were planted in 2012 and today the Rathfinny vineyard comprises over 230 acres of predominantly Pinot Noir, Chardonnay and Pinot Meunier.

## Wiston Estate

This lesser-known alternative to Prosecco comes from Veneto and is the sparkling wine of choice in the bars around Verona. 100% Durello. Approachable, gently fruity, solid juice for the price.

## Colesel

This is a recent addition to our portfolio, from the prestigious Valdobbiadene region at the foot of the Dolomites, with some vines in the legendary Cartizze vineyards. The Prato Scuro Brut is a mind-blower – way more refined and elegant than most of the Prosecco available in the U.S. market.

Made exclusively from Glera grapes grown on double-arched cane trained vines, it represents the finest tradition of the region. The grapes are carefully harvested between September 10-30th, with max yields of 6 tons per acre to ensure optimal concentration of flavors. The wine undergoes a delicate white vinification process with soft pressing to preserve its aromatic qualities. Primary fermentation happens in temperature-controlled steel tanks, followed by a 30-day secondary fermentation using the Charmat method. The wine is then matured for 1-2 months before bottling.

With just 8 g/l of residual sugar, this Brut style Prosecco offers a refreshing profile balanced by 5.8 g/l of acidity and 11% ABV.

## Lunato Lambrusco

Fruit is sourced from select vineyards throughout the region, soft-pressed in stainless steel along with the skins for 4 to 6 days where it is vinified using the Charmat method. The result is a fragrant, fruity sparkling Lambrusco. Light in body and well-balanced in style. Very refreshing with sweet red berry flavors making it an easy-drinking wine. Low in alcohol, a medium-dry style of Lambrusco. 8% ABV.

## Marcalberto

Marcalberto is a stellar sparkling wine producer in the heart of Nebbiolo country, about 20 minutes east of Alba. The winery was started in 1993 by Piero Cane and is named for his two sons- Marco and Alberto who now run the winery and farm the 10 hectares of Pinot Noir and Chardonnay that yields about 7500 cases of wine annually. The wines are focused and precise- beautifully made.

## Palladiano Durello

The Durello grape is local to the Veneto region, grown on the volcanic hillsides of Monti Lessini. The name of the grape refers to the small, late-maturing berries (Duro = hard). Durello's naturally high acidity produces complex, long lived wines. Production of Durello Spumante is mostly in the hands of a few small growers, and the variety is well-suited to the production of fresh, zesty, tank-method wines such as this sparkler from Palladiano. Aged for 2-3 months on lees. Citrus and gently floral aromas and a zippy palate with crisp green apple and lightly honeyed characters.

## Elio Perrone

Stefano Perrone is descended from a long line of grape growers in Castiglione Tinella, the heart of Asti. When he took over the family estate, he began by pursuing lower yields and eliminating artificial fertilizers and pesticides in his vineyards. He focused on harvesting at just the right moment, always seeking to achieve greater freshness and balance in his wines, gradually earning a reputation as one of the appellation's premier producers.

Extraordinarily luscious with vivid fruit, soft mousse and captivating perfume, Moscato is a versatile aperitif, superb after dinner wine on its own or with a light dessert.

## Tocco Prosecco

Prior to the founding of winery I Magredi in 1968, the site was planted to apple and peach orchards. In 1989, Michelangelo Tombacco Treviso began planting vineyards. The soil is unusually stony reminiscent of the New Zealand vineyards in the Gimblett Gravels region. It's still a family winery today, but because we direct import the wine we can offer a better quality Prosecco than the co-op stuff that most of the competition sells in this price range.

## Los Monteros

Boutinot has partnered with Los Monteros winery in Utiel-Requena, Spain, to bring small-production sparkling wine to market. Located west of Valencia, Utiel-Requena is a region with a rich winemaking history dating back to the 7th century BC, known for its resilient vineyards and exceptional terroir. ## Mont-Marçal

The Estate was founded in 1975 upon purchase of a 19th-century convent in the heart of the Penedès region. The excellent base wine is produced from Xarel·lo, Macabeo and Chardonnay; the Rosado is 100% Trepat. Aged between 18 & 24 months on the yeast, and disgorged on order. Intrinsic vineyard quality and careful handling of the grapes obtain a naturally-rich base wine that is in little need of dosage to achieve a remarkable level of complexity and depth.

## Torre Oria

A tremendous value in Cava from down near Valencia. A blend of Macabeo and Chardonnay, it has remarkably tiny bubbles for something this inexpensive, with none of that heavy-handed fruit that you so often find in Cava of this price. Lean and crisp with great acidity. Punches way above its price range!

### Eyrie

This sparkling wine is a meticulously crafted blend from Eyrie's certified-organic estate vineyards, combining 48% Pinot Noir, 6% Meunier, 9% Chardonnay, 5% Pinot Blanc, and 31% Chasselas doré. Employing regenerative no-till farming and extended lees aging, the wine offers a complex profile of pear, citrus, blood orange, and wild strawberry flavors, with crisp acids and creamy notes balanced by subtle effervescence. Fermented in wood and steel, carbonated to 4.2 atmospheres, and bottled under convenient crown cap with zero residual sugar, the wine reflects a commitment to sustainable viticulture and nuanced winemaking.

### Foris

Sustainably-farmed. Foris Vineyards has been cultivating Early Muscat since 1976, inspired by Italian Moscato to create a playful, effervescent wine. By arresting fermentation midway, they preserve the grape's natural sweetness and carbonation, resulting in a delicately sparkling wine with white peach, pear, and floral notes. This low-alcohol, bright, and refreshing Moscato is perfect for summer celebrations and as an aperitif. 8.3% ABV; 10g RS.

### Grochau Cellars

100% Pinot noir from sustainably-farmed Festive Vineyard (McMinnville AVA) and One Heart Vineyard (South Salem Hills). Grapes are gently pressed and the juice is fermented in stainless steel tanks. The wine is aged on lees for 4 months before preparing the wine for bottling. Zero dosage, so you have a bright and fresh sparkler with a lovely rose hue. Crown cap.

Soter Mineral Springs Brut Rose comes from Demeter-certified Biodynamic, CCOF certified Organic vineyards and blends the finest elements of Champagne winemaking techniques to create a distinctive Oregon-style wine. 70% Pinot noir, 30% Chardonnay.

Planet Oregon is made from 100% Organically farmed Willamette Valley Pinot Noir, and a portion of all sales are donated to the Oregon Environmental Council.
